On June 1, 2013, pursuant to Chapter 28, Statutes of 2012 (AB 1494), we submitted the Healthy Families Program Transition to Medi-Cal Phase – Network Adequacy Assessment Report – Phase 4 (“Phase 4 Assessment”) to the state Legislature. However, that Phase 4 Assessment did not include any specific information about network adequacy for each county. The First Addendum to the Phase 4 Assessment was issued on July 29, 2013, which provided a full network assessment of the Medi-Cal Managed Care Networks for Phase 4A counties - Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Modoc, Shasta, Siskiyou, and Trinity.

The attached Second Addendum to the Phase 4 Assessment includes detailed network information by county for each of the Phase 4B counties—Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Imperial, Inyo, Mariposa, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, San Benito, Sierra, Sutter, Tehama, Tuolumne, and Yuba. The Phase 4B Addendum concludes that the Medi-Cal Managed Care Networks in each affected county have adequate capacity to serve transitioning and incoming enrollees. It specifically compares access in Medi-Cal Managed Care Networks in each county to the access that enrollees have today in the Healthy Families Program, and it shows that in most counties there is moderate to high overlap between the Healthy Families Program and the Medi-Cal primary care providers.

We remain committed to making this transition as smooth as possible for children and their families. We welcome and appreciate feedback from you, your staff, and stakeholders as we finalize this process.
